Sub : Admission to the Three-year MBA Course 2010-2013

2. The fees for the course are as follows:

- (a) Fee for the 1st year : Rs. 1,62,000/- (including admission, tuition and development fees)
: Rs. 5,000/- (refundable Library Caution deposit)
: Rs. 5,000/- (refundable Security deposit)

Students are suggested to arrange their own Laptop as advanced learning accessories.

- (b) Fee for the 2nd year : Rs. 1,54,000/- (including tuition and development fees)

- (c) Fee for the 3rd year : Rs. 1,54,000/- (including tuition and development fees)

The sum of Rs. 1,72,000/- is to be paid by A/C Payee Bank draft in favour of "Indian Institute of Social Welfare and Business Management" at the time of admission. The Draft may be drawn on any bank whose Service Branch is in Kolkata and should reach the Institute by **June 29, 2010**.

- 3 Candidates who have passed their degree examination from a University other than Calcutta University must get a Migration Certificate and submit the same to Calcutta University within one month from the date of commencement of classes.

4. Final admission will be based on your qualification being approved by the University of Calcutta for admission to MBA Degree course.
