THE INSTITUTE

IISWBM is the first and premier management institution in the country. The institute started its journey on 25th April 1953 by a resolution passed by the Senate of the University of Calcutta. The institute is the culmination of the joint initiative taken by the University of Calcutta, the Government of West Bengal, the Government of India and the captains of industry. The Government of India, Department of Posts, in recognition of 50 years of glory of the first B-School in the country, released a Commemorative Postage Stamp on IISWBM in 2004. In more than 67 years of its journey, the institute has been the pioneer in starting new business and socially relevant programs and steered them through.

THE 2-YEAR FULL-TIME MBA-PUBLIC SYSTEMS PROGRAM (MBA-PS)

The Public Systems Program was started in 1993 at the behest of the recommendations of the Task Force constituted by the Ministry of HRD, Government of India. It was increasingly felt that there is a lack of-professional management in the areas of Energy management, Environment management, Healthcare and Hospital management and Transportation & Logistics management. Present estimate states that there is a demand-supply gap of about 30% between the requirement and availability of professional managers in these areas of public systems management. The present program intends to fill this void.

The industry has been a patron of this programme since inception. All graduates receive placement assistance and many of the 2000 + alumni of the program are employed in the country and abroad in key strategic decision making positions.





The MBA-Public Systems has four specializations:

Energy Management:

The specialization has been grooming the students in response to industrial and social need to face the challenge from depletion of resources and attain sustainability of business in India and abroad. The course harmonizes knowledge and skills development in the areas of energy conservation, renewable energy, energy economics, trading and policy, green building and evolving issues. This is the only course in India approved by the Association of Energy Engineers (USA). Every year eligible students of Energy Dept receive International Scholarship from AEE (US).

Environment Management:

Aims at heightening environmental concern in business practices, green awareness, eco-friendly productions, usage of natural resources, policy-making in sustainable management, controlling pollution of habitats, addressing compliance and corporate social responsibility issues and integrating environmental issues in strategic business planning.

Healthcare and Hospital Management:

Equips the students with appropriate efficiency in systematic management practices, at the same time strengthening their operational base to meet the health challenges of reducing the cost, improving the quality and making it accessible and available to all.

Transportation and logistics Management:

Imparts students with knowledge on various aspects of supply chain and transportation management through introductory and advanced level course delivery. Students are equipped with methodologies, tools and software that enable them to analyze, design and manage agile, adaptive and resilient supply chain.

Eligibility

Honours candidates or equivalent course (where Honours are not available), from a recognized university with minimum 50% marks (45% in case of SC/ST/PWD/NC-OBC) and Graduates in any professional course (Engineering, etc.) LLB (5 years) of a recognized University. Experienced candidates preferred.

ENERGY MANAGEMENT-

B.E./B.Tech in Engineering, AMIE, Graduate with Honours in (Physics / Chemistry / Mathematics/ Economics). Bachelor in Business Administration, Computer Applications are eligible to apply.

ENVIRONMENT MANAGEMENT-

Graduates with Honours or equivalent in Engineering (B.E./B.Tech), AMIE / Science / Economics / BBA are eligible to apply. Masters degree students in all the above disciplines can also apply.

HEALTH CARE AND HOSPITAL MANAGEMENT-

MBBS, AYUSH, BBA, BHMS, BAMS, BUMS, BDS, BPTB. OPTM, LLB, Bachelor in Business Administration, Graduates with Honours or equivalent in Pharmacy, Science, Economics, Commerce, Nursing, Nutrition and Engineering, AM IE are eligible to apply.

TRANSPORTATION & LOGISTICS MANAGEMENT-

Graduates with honours or equivalent, in Engineering, AMIE / Science / Commerce / Arts / Economics / Business Administration / Computer Applications are eligible to apply.

Master degree students in all the above disciplines can also apply.

All graduates must have a degree from AICTE / UGC approved Colleges / Universities / Institutes and should have at least 50% marks in total.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The applicants for the admission to the MBA-PS Course are required to take CAT / MAT / CMAT / JEMAT / GATE / GMAT / ATMA. The candidates short-listed on the basis of cutoff marks in the above selection tests would be required to appear for a group discussion and personal interview at IISWBM, Kolkata. The Final selection of candidates will be strictly on the basis of merit. The composite score is calculated on the basis of relative weightage in four categories, viz. academic qualifications & work experience, MAT / CAT / CMAT / JEMAT / GATE / ATMA / GMAT Score, Performance in Group Discussion (GD) and Personal Interview (PI). SCI ST / OBC Candidates will be selected as per norms.

Group Discussion and Personal Interview:

A candidate will be allotted a date for group discussion, and personal interview and will complete the process during the same day.

Foreign/NRI/PIO Students

A Candidate from abroad may apply, giving details of academic background along with a certiffied copy of passport and other relevant documents. GMAT/equivalent score is desirable. Admission may be considered subject to Bachelor's Degree qualification and any other requirements of University of Calcutta.

Laboratory Facilities


Laboratory facilities and field visit / studies / experiment / live project opportunities are readily available as the Institute undertakes quite a number of prestigious research and consultancy assignments. The Institute has state of the art Energy and Environment Laboratories.

The laboratories are also used for research and consultancy projects and enable the students to gain hands on experience while actively participating in the different consultancy projects undertaken by the Institute. Students are required to conduct experiments and supplement their theoretical knowledge.

IISWBM's Energy Laboratory is well equipped with a 640 watt peak Solar Photovoltaic Power Research Station and a number of electrical and mechanical energy measuring equipments some of which are listed below and softwares like TRNSYS, e-Quest etc. which are required for energy study and for conducting Energy Audit in energy intensive industries such as paper, power, cement and commercial buildings. Virtually the laboratory is extended to remote areas in Sunderbans, to large industrial establishments as students are engaged in the Institute's field research and consultancy services. The Energy Laboratory has also been adorned with various awards from the Association of Energy Engineers AEE (USA). IISWBM Energy Management Dept. is the India Chapter of AEE(USA).

The Institute also has set up a Groundwater Modelling Laboratory and GIS cell in the Department of Environment Management of the Public Systems Management Programme. The principle objective of this is to impart quality training to the students on Water Resource Management, GIS and Remote Sensing and to carry out different research projects and consultancy. Faculty members of the Environment Departments have executed several projects funded by the Department of Science and Technology, Government of India; Council for Scientific and Industrial Research, Government of India; United States Geological Survey; Calcutta Urban Services, Kolkata; SIMA VI, Netherlands, Hindalco, Ministry of Defence, Govt. of India (Ichapur Rifle Factory and Cossipore Gun and Shell Factory), National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC) etc.

Faculty members of this departments also tie-up and collaborate with various industry for research work. These includes United States Geological Survey, University of Delware, USA, University College London, U.K., Nanyang Technological University, Singapore, Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur, Centre for Ground Water Studies, Kolkata and Central University of Gujarat.


