





# INFRASTRUCTURE



IISWBM Central Library was started along with the establishment of the Institute in 1953 in order to cater to the academic and research needs of the faculty, research scholars, students, officers and non-teaching staff. Since then, the Institute Library has gone from strength to strength to live up to the expectations of its users. Central Library has open-access facility for the members. It provides lending, reprographic and bibliographic and other services to the students, faculty and other scholars. The books in the Library are arranged according to the DDC numbers mainly on specialized subjects on management, Social Welfare, Industrial safety, Transport, Environment, Energy, Health Services, Economics, Mercantile and Labour Law, Bio-Informatics, Sports and Intellectual property etc. The Library subscribes good number of foreign as well as Indian periodicals and journals. The Library also has e-journal and e-books for the benefit of the users. The Central Library has already implemented the bar-code based circulation system. The members can also search the OPAC through LIBSYS. The Library is under the CCTV surveillance.



An 11,000 sq. ft. girl's hostel adjacent to the Academic block of the Institute has been inaugurated on 6th August, 2012 for accommodating 42 girl students. This facility provides fully furnished rooms with attached bathrooms (2-seater and 3-seater), canteen, large dining hall furnished to accommodate 32 diners at a time, kitchen, common living area fitted with LCD TV, terrace, microwave ovens, refrigerator, water coolers and purifiers, ironing table, irons, recreational facilities like carom etc. and professional round the clock security services.

The Institute has a Web Assisted Language Laboratory to support students in the language learning process. Innovative interactive tools such as digital multimedia control, wireless headsets and microphones are provided not only to enhance language teaching but also to enable instructors accomplish continuous assessment and grading of students' performance.

Recreation can be the ideal getaway for the students amidst a hard-core routine of academic pursuits. The Student Activity Center has been built to make the students participate in various kinds of programmes from time to time. They can exchange ideas, relax, engage in debates and discussions to widen their horizons in various spheres. The blend of a disciplined educational regimen with meaningful activity helps them to prosper as complete business leaders in the years to come. It is also a perfect place to unwind, share ideas and participate in vociferous discussions.

The IISWBM canteen serves students with good quality food at a subsidised price

range. There are a varied range of wholesome snacks and meals to choose from, which can be enjoyed by the students, staff and faculty. The system of Wi-Fi enabled digital communication in the canteen helps students continue with their learning process while they relax. The meals are served promptly to cater to students within short breaks.

The Institute is equipped with state of the art IT facilities. It has a large IT Laboratory

(Business Intelligence Lab) with more than 50 work stations and modern Audio Video facilities. This Lab is used for students to learn various MIS and DSS tools on hands on mode. The Lab is also supported with statistical software like SPSS and Business Analytics Tools such as R, Rapid Miner, and Rattle etc.

The Institute has installed FACT ERP for processing financial accounts, payroll and HR applications. The library is equipped with Libsys, comprehensive popular software, which automates all the library activities from procurement of books, membership to management of issues and receipts and books.


# **COURSE OVERVIEW**

MBA (HRM) is a globally accredited 2 year full time programme in Human Resource Management. It has been certified by SHRM (USA) along with other top notch universities like University of Minnesota, New York University, Purdue University, University of Colorado, Western Carolina University, etc.

Unlike any other general management course, it particularly focuses on an advanced learning of the Industrial & Labour Laws, Organizational Behavior, Organizational Development, Psychometric Tools of HRM, HR Analytics, HR Consulting in order to meet industry requirements.

Role Plays, Case Studies, Group Presentation pertaining to plausible corporate scenario, HR, IR, and Economically relevant cases make classroom study a myth. Modern Audio Visual aids are used to make learning more interactive and appealing to students.

To keep up with pace of time & demand of the industry and to empower the students, the course has also introduced SPSS, to analyse & interpret various aspects of human behavior through statistics and its applications. This is an approach to make HR a quantitative wing of management, rather than a qualitative one. Admission to the course are based on CAT Scores, Group Discussion & Personal Interview.













  Placement Talk (PPT) on a mutual convenient date or share the details via mail.
- CTC disclosure prior to selection process is a pre-requisite.
- Profiles of interested and eligible candidates are shared with the company.
- During placement season, there could be a possibility of two or more companies conducting
  placement drive simultaneously. In such case, whichever company rolls out the job offer first
  shall get the candidate.
- In order to facilitate the recruitment process, institute will provide the necessary infrastructure.
- Companies participating in the Institute's Placement Process may kindly note that delay in announcing and confirming the job offers, may result in the selected/shortlisted candidate being placed in another company.
- If the organization wishes to interview candidates for their Summer Internship, the Placement Cell will facilitate in organizing the same. Period of Internship being two months (June-July).


