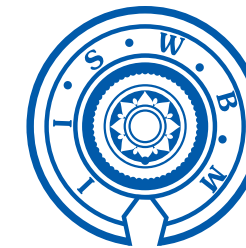

## The Institute

IISWBM was constituted on 25<sup>th</sup> April 1953 by a resolution passed by the Senate of the University of Calcutta. This was the culmination of the joint initiative taken by the University of Calcutta, Government of West Bengal, Government of India and the captains of industry in India to set up for the first time a management education institute in India, a concept alien to many in the educational fraternity at that time. IISWBM, the first management institute of India was thus established by Dr. B. C. Roy, the then Chief Minister of West Bengal as its Founder-President and Prof. D. K. Sanyal as the founder Director. Government of India, Department of Posts in recognition of 50 years of glorious existence of the first B-school in the country, released a Commemorative Postage Stamp on IISWBM, on 25<sup>th</sup> April 2004 in New Delhi.
