The Hon'ble Supreme Court has issued the following directions to prevent ragging in TechnicalInstitutions-

We recommended that every institution must have an Anti-Ragging Committee and an Anti-RaggingSquad.

It is essential to have a diverse mix of membership in terms of levels as well as gender in both the Anti-Ragging Committee at the level of the Institution should consist of the representatives of civil and policeadministration, local media, Non-Governmental Organizations involved in youth activities, representatives of faculty members, representatives of parents, representatives of students belonging to the fresher's category as well as seniors, non-teaching staff and should be headed by the Head of theInstitutions.

The Anti-Raging Squad, in contrast, should be a body with vigil, oversight and patrolling functions andshould appropriately by a smaller body which should be nominated by the Head of the Institute withsuchrepresentationasconsidered necessarytokeepit mobile, alertandactiveat alltime.

The Squad may be called upon to make surprise raids on hostels and other hot sports and should workundertheoverallguidanceof Anti-RaggingCommittee.

The Squad should not have any outside representation and should only consist of members belonging to the various sections of the campus community.
