

WE CARE 2024

The official 'WE CARE' event of the MSW Department for the year of 2024 was a grand success. The target for this year was to bring a smile to the ones' unfortunate. To stand by those, abandoned by their own family, and to make a small dent in their otherwise mundane life. The oath was 'to help those who cannot help themselves'

The students after a lot of thought and with the aegis of their eminent faculty members decided to raise funds, clothes and food packets for the elderly and orphan children. The shortlisted 4 areas for visit and donations were:-

- **Grihoheen Ashray Prokolpo- Golfgreen**
- **Sampark Orphanage Home- Haridevpur**
- **Dumdum Correctional Home**
- **Nari Seva Sangha**

The month-long event started with raising fund through online and offline methods. With the sizable fortune of 18,500/- the students bought clothes, stationery(notebooks, pens, pencils, colour pencils, crayons, a World map, an India's map & a globe) and games items. The various donations received included food items(corn flakes, rice, flour, biscuit, chocolates & maggi packets) and gently used clothes.

The visits were done in phases.

The first phase- on **21st September** the students visited the **Grihoheen Ashray Prokolpo- Golfgreen & Sampark Orphanage Home- Haridevpur**, to provide clothes and stationery items to the elderly and orphan children





The second phase- on **27th September** the students visited the **Dum Dum Correctional Home** to provide some stationary items, chocolates, the maps and game items to the inmate's children.



The third phase- on **1st October** the students visited the **Nari Seva Sangha** associated school for the underprivileged and provided some fund, stationery and food items.



It was a fulfilling event, a tad bit tiresome and a whole lot of educational. The students learned fundraising & teamwork. The visits helped the students navigate through the feelings of gratitude and humility, after seeing the content faces of the beneficiaries. Though the event has come to an end for this year, the students will strive lifelong to do their part in giving back to the society.
