

1953 – Visionary Foundation for Social Welfare

The Indian Institute of Social Welfare and Business Management (IISWBM) was established in 1953 under the visionary leadership of Dr. Bidhan Chandra Roy, the then Chief Minister of West Bengal. Conceived as an institution rooted in social welfare, IISWBM aimed to develop professionally trained managers committed to nation-building and societal progress in post-independence India.

National Thought Leadership and Institution-Building

The founding philosophy of IISWBM resonated strongly with the ideas of national leaders such as Jawaharlal Nehru, who



emphasized scientific temper, planned development, and professional management as essential instruments for India's economic and social transformation.

To link an intellectual experience with the sense of social responsibilities with the purpose of marrying social welfare to business management.

Mission of the Institution

- To provide students an inter-disciplinary training so that they may gain a holistic view of any organization.
- To train students for activities relevant to the contemporary socio-economic activities of the country.

In its formative years, IISWBM emerged as a pioneer in public administration education, offering structured training for civil servants, administrators, and public sector executives. This milestone reflected the institute's commitment to strengthening governance, policy implementation, and public systems management in a developing democracy.

University Affiliation and Corporate Management Orientation :



Academic Structuring with Global Management Perspective :




