Instructions to Candidates

1. Candidates scheduled for the **11:00 AM session** are required to report by **10:30 AM**.
2. Candidates scheduled for the **1:00 PM session** are required to report by **12:30 PM**.
3. Candidates are required to bring **all original certificates/documents** and one set of **self-attested photocopies** of the relevant documents for verification.
4. Each candidate will be required to make a brief **presentation of his/her proposed Research Area/Research Interest**, followed by an interview with the concerned Committee.



5. Candidates are advised to prepare a **PowerPoint presentation** covering, preferably, the following:
- Proposed Research Area/Title;
 - Background and rationale of the proposed research;
 - Statement of the research problem;
 - Research objectives;
 - Brief review of relevant literature;
 - Proposed research methodology;
 - Expected outcome and contribution of the proposed research.
6. Candidates should keep the presentation **concise and focused**, preferably within **10-15 minutes**.
7. Candidates should also bring a copy of their **research proposal/research concept note**.
8. Candidates are advised to ensure that their presentation is compatible with the available computer/projector facilities and to carry a copy of the presentation in a **USB drive** as a precaution.

Candidates are required to appear at the venue strictly according to the time slot allotted to them.



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
